BENEVOLENCE POLICY Cedarcreek Community Church

"For there was not a needy person among them, for all who were owners of land or houses would sell them and bring the proceeds of the sales, and lay them at the apostle's feet; and they would be distributed to each as any had need." Acts 2:34-35.

Cedarcreek Community Church will maintain a special Benevolence Account in order to meet financial or other needs of people to whom the church is ministering. This policy shall govern the disbursement of funds from this special account.

- 1. The Benevolence Account will be funded by special donations specifically designated for that account, or by a designation of general funds by a vote of the Trustees.
- 2. Only funds from the Benevolence Account shall be given as benevolence gifts.
- 3. The Board of Trustees, or any committee or staff the Board may appoint, shall determine the amount of any benevolence gift. The Board may adopt procedures to guide any committee or staff appointed to make said decisions.
