GCC began as a very loose association of churches, connected primarily by relationships. Over the years, GCC has grown into a more organized association. The organizational structure of GCC has developed over the years as the movement grew in numbers and spread over a much great distance. Most recently, GCC has been many local churches, each in a Region, with each Region part of a national entity.
