## CEDARCREEK COMMUNITY CHURCH Board of Trustees

The Cedarcreek Community Church Board of Trustees acts as a financial overseer for the Church. The Board is created by the Church's Bylaws, which grants it specific authority:

SECTION 1.4: Authority. The Board shall be responsible for the administration of all of the financial business of the Church. This authority shall be limited to matters involving the income received and expenses incurred by the Church, including, but not limited to, salaries, capital expenditures, purchase and sale of real and personal assets. All other matters, whether spiritual, personnel, programming or others, are reserved to the Pastors. *From the Church Bylaws* 

The Board meets monthly to review and discuss the financial status of the Church. The Board is charged with developing and overseeing a yearly budget. The Board makes decisions regarding capital expenditures and long-term financial planning.

All Board members must attend at least 75% of the scheduled meetings each year in order to remain on the Board. Attendance will be recorded by the Secretary and reviewed at the end of each year. If a Board member does not meet the required attendance the Pastors will discuss with said Member about whether or not to continue as a Board Member for the following year.

The Board is charged with administering the Church's Benevolence Fund. This function may be delegated to a standing committee made up of Board members and other church members.

Members of the Board are appointed by the Pastors for a two year term. Board members must be regular attenders of Cedarcreek Community Church.
