God chose to create the world in six days and rest on the seventh.

This established a work/rest rhythm. *Genesis 1:3-2:3*

God blessed the seventh day and made it holy.

He set it apart, consecrated it to holy purposes. Genesis 2:3

Bless [NW1828]: 4. To set apart or consecrate to holy purposes; to make and pronounce holy.

Holy [NW1828]: 2. Hallowed; consecrated or set apart to a sacred use, or to the service or worship of God; a sense frequent in Scripture; as the holy sabbath

God included the sabbath, the seventh day in the 10 commandments.

Exodus 20:8-11 Deuteronomy 5:12-15

God specifically calls out a rebellion against the work/rest rhythm. Ezekiel 20

Profane [NW1828]: To violate any thing sacred, or treat it with abuse, irreverence, obloquy or contempt
