## **ADAM – COVENANTAL HEAD**

**COVENANT [NW1828]**: To enter into a formal agreement; to stipulate; to bind oneself by contract.

**HEAD [NW1828]** (*adjective*): chief; principal; as a head workman.

**HEAD [NW1828]** (*verb*): To lead; to direct; to act as leader to; as, to head an army; to head an expedition; to head a riot.
