# Sin Revealed

<sup>12</sup>Therefore, just as sin came into the world through one man, and death through sin, and so death spread to all men because all sinned – Romans 5:12



# Husband Head of Wife

<sup>23</sup>For the husband is the head of the wife even as Christ is the head of the church, his body, and is himself its Savior. – Ephesians 5:23



# Husband Head of Wife

Responsible [**NW1828**]: 1. Liable to account; accountable; answerable; as for a trust reposed, or for a debt.
