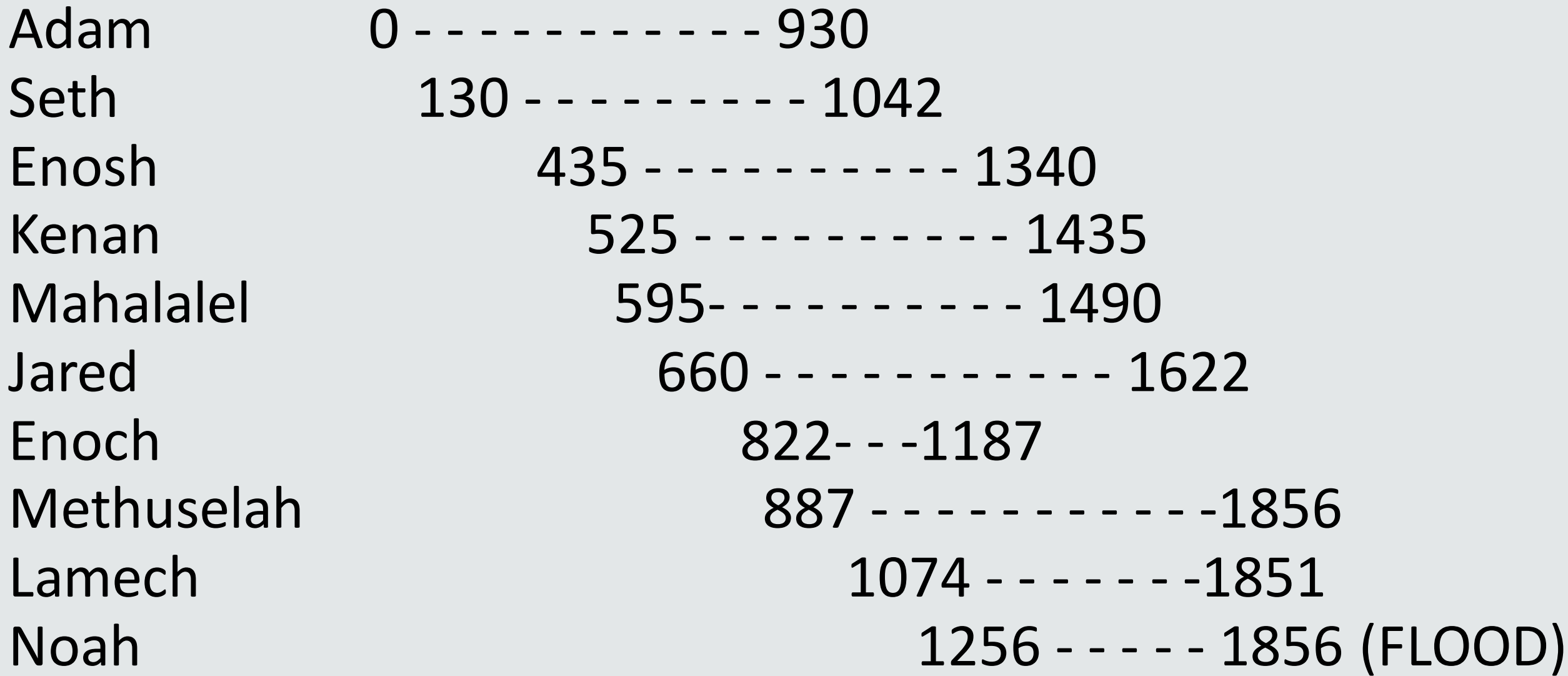
# Change in Interaction
