### What is Good & Evil

The Lord saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every intention of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually. – **Genesis 6:5**

... the intention of man's heart is evil from his youth ... – **Genesis 8:21**

Genesis 3, Psalm 51:5, Jeremiah 17:9, Romans 3:23, Matthew 15:19

**Good:** that which is morally right; righteousness.

**Evil:** profoundly immoral and wicked.

**Good [NW1828]:** Having moral qualities best adapted to its design and use, or the qualities **which God's law requires**; virtuous; pious; religious; applied to persons, and opposed to bad, vicious, wicked, evil.

**Evil [NW1828]:** [...] Moral evil is any deviation of a moral agent from the rules of conduct **prescribed to him by God**, or by legitimate human authority; or it is any violation of the plain principles of justice and rectitude.

### **From the Heart**

John 14:23-24, 15:10,14

Disobedient in action & rebellious from the heart

Obedient in action & rebellious from the heart

Obedient in action from the heart to the Lord

### **God Regretted**

And the Lord regretted that he had made man on the earth, and it grieved him to his heart.

– **Genesis 6:6**

But they rebelled and grieved his Holy Spirit; therefore he turned to be their enemy, and himself fought against them. – **Isaiah 63:10**

And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. – **Ephesians 4:30**

### **The Point of No Return**

So the Lord said, "I will blot out man whom I have created from the face of the land, man and animals and creeping things and birds of the heavens, for I am sorry that I have made them." – **Genesis 6:7**

2 Peter 2:5

They do not cry to me from the heart, but they wail upon their beds; for grain and wine they gash themselves; they rebel against me. – **Hosea 7:14**

Zechariah 7:8-14

As I called, and they would not hear, so they called, and I would not hear," says the Lord of hosts.
