What is Good & Evil

Good: that which is morally right; righteousness.

Evil: profoundly immoral and wicked.

What is Good & Evil

Good [NW1828]: Having moral qualities best adapted to its design and use, or the qualities which God's law requires; virtuous; pious; religious; applied to persons, and opposed to bad, vicious, wicked, evil.



What is Good & Evil

Evil [NW1828]: [...] Moral evil is any deviation of a moral agent from the rules of conduct prescribed to him by God, or by legitimate human authority; or it is any violation of the plain principles of justice and rectitude.
