



Covenant

yet we know that a person is not justified by works of the law but through faith in Jesus Christ [...] because by works of the law no one will be justified.

- Galatians 2:16

I do not nullify the grace of God, for if righteousness were through the law, then Christ died for no purpose.


Covenant
