The Best of Us Are Very Flawed.

Abram – Went from a coward and a fool to an idolater

David:

"For I know my transgressions, and my sin is always before me." – Psalm 51:3

God Keeps His Promises: He Loves And Includes Very Flawed People.

Abram: *"I will make you into a great nation, and I will bless you"* – Genesis 12:2

David: *"Now I will make your name great, like the names of the greatest men of the earth."* – 2 Samuel 7:9

We Can Do Right in The Midst of Very Flawed People.

Sarai: *"like Sarah, who obeyed Abraham and called him her master. You are her daughters if you do what is right and do not give way to fear."* – 1 Peter 3:6
