

Genesis 14:17-20 Melchizedek

Observations:

17 After his return from the defeat of Chedorlaomer and the kings who were with him, the king of Sodom went out to meet him at the Valley of Shaveh (that is, the King's Valley). – Genesis 14:17

[Romans 2:4]

18 And Melchizedek king of Salem brought out bread and wine. (He was priest of God Most High.) - Genesis 14:18

19 And he blessed him and said,

“Blessed be Abram by God Most High, Possessor of heaven and earth; 20 and blessed be God Most High, who has delivered your enemies into your hand!”

And Abram gave him a tenth of everything. – Genesis 14:19-20

Hebrews 7:1-10 [5:7-10, 7:15-17]

Jesus – King

King [NW1828]: The chief or sovereign of a nation; a man invested with supreme authority over a nation, tribe or country; a monarch.

[Isaiah 9:6-7, Hebrews 1:3-4, Revelation 17:14]

Discernment, Obedience, Endurance, Peace & Security, etc.

Jesus – Priest

*For every high priest chosen from among **men is appointed to act on behalf of men in relation to God, to offer gifts and sacrifices for sins.** – Hebrews 5:1*
