Assessing the Situation

- Abram=85; Sarai=76 No Kids
- ·Sarai: "Lord has kept" "I can build"
- ·Abram: Believed promise. Not working.
- •We need another plan.



Abram & Sarai's New Plan

"Sarai his wife took her Egyptian maidservant Hagar and gave her to her husband to be his wife. He slept with Hagar, and she conceived."

-Genesis 16:3-4



When the Plan Falls Apart

- Hagar Despise Sarai
- Sarai Resent Hagar; Blame Abram;
 Justifies Herself
- Abram Passive
- •Hagar Ran away
