Fulfilling the Passover

Old Testament Passover

- slaves in a foreign land
- judgment was coming
- sacrifice unblemished lamb
- blood saved them from destruction

Fulfillment in Christ

- we are slaves to sin
- judgment is coming
- Jesus is the perfect sacrifice
- His blood redeems us from our sins
