

Genesis 19:1-22

Mercy [NW1828]: 1. That benevolence, mildness or tenderness of heart which disposes a person to overlook injuries, or to treat an offender better than he deserves; the disposition that tempers justice, and induces an injured person to forgive trespasses and injuries, and to forbear punishment, or inflict less than law or justice will warrant [...] It implies benevolence, tenderness, mildness, pity or compassion, and clemency, but exercised only towards offenders. Mercy is a distinguishing attribute of the Supreme Being.

2. An act or exercise of mercy or favor. It is a mercy that they escaped.
3. Pity; compassion manifested towards a person in distress.
