Called to follow Jesus (Mark 1:16-18)

Given a prominent role (Mat. 16:17-19)

Denied he knew Jesus (Luke 22:54-62)

Questioned his status (Mat. 10:32-34)

Huge catch of large fish

How? Peter's Call v. Reinstatement:

New role compared to fish/fishing
Peter left all to follow

-Luke 5:1-11; John 21:1-19

Heart was broken(Luke 22:62)

Will was fixed(Luke 5:8; John 21:7)

-compare to Judas (Matthew 27:1-5)
