#### Edom Was In God's Sight And Mind

- •Would be conquered -Numbers 24:18
- •Would be spared -Daniel 11:41
- •Would be punished -Amos 1:11-12



#### Fractured Relationship With Israel

- •Occasionally allies -2 Kings 3
- Mostly fought each other
  - -Moses/Saul/David/Solomon
    Jehoshaphat/Amaziah/Jehoram



### Edom's Most Defining Characteristic

Enduring hatred of Israel *-Ezekiel 35:5*Culminated in Babylonian Exile *-Psalm 137:7; Obadiah 11-14* 

Result: Total Destruction

-Obadiah 10; Isaiah 34:8-10
