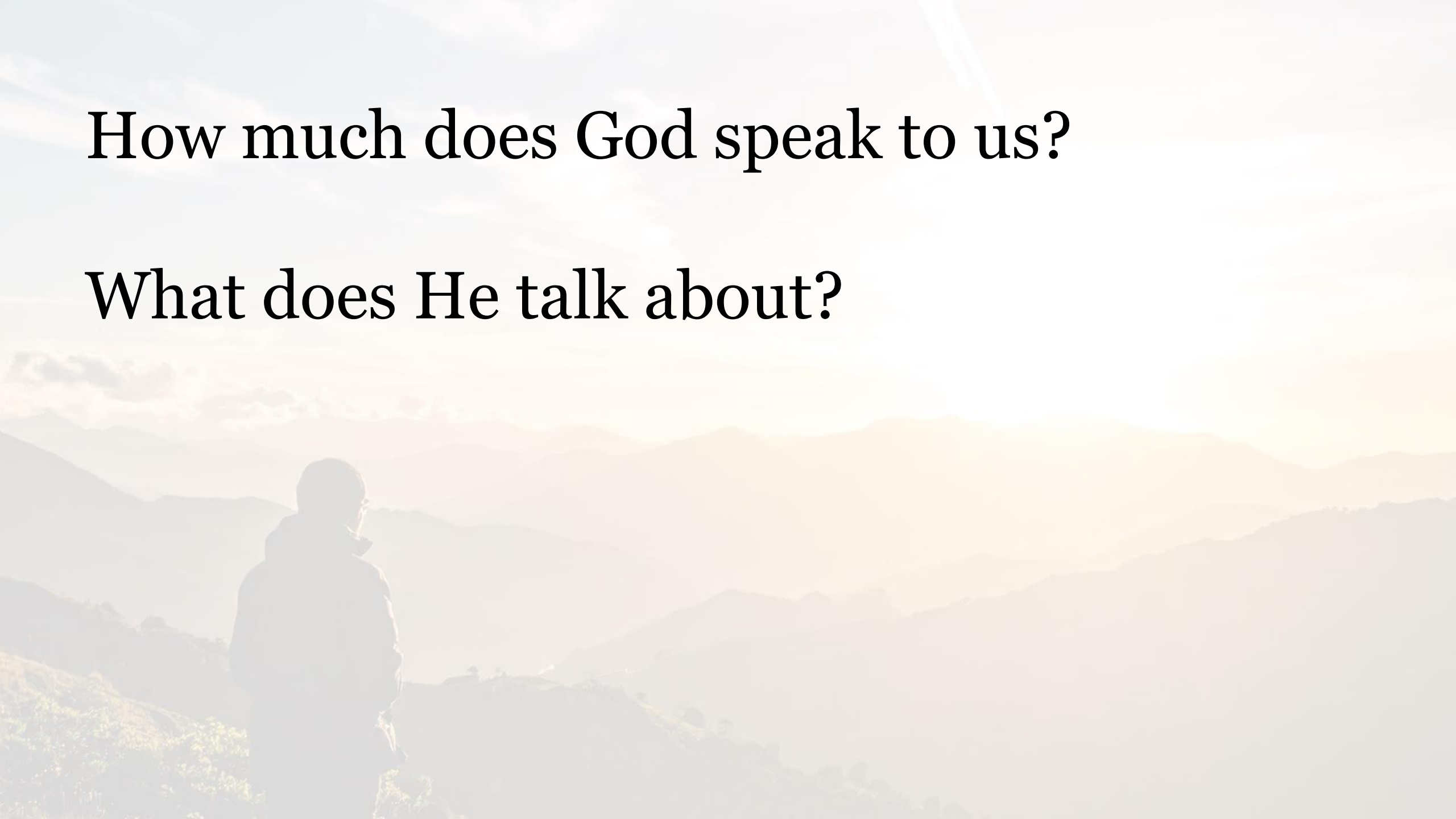

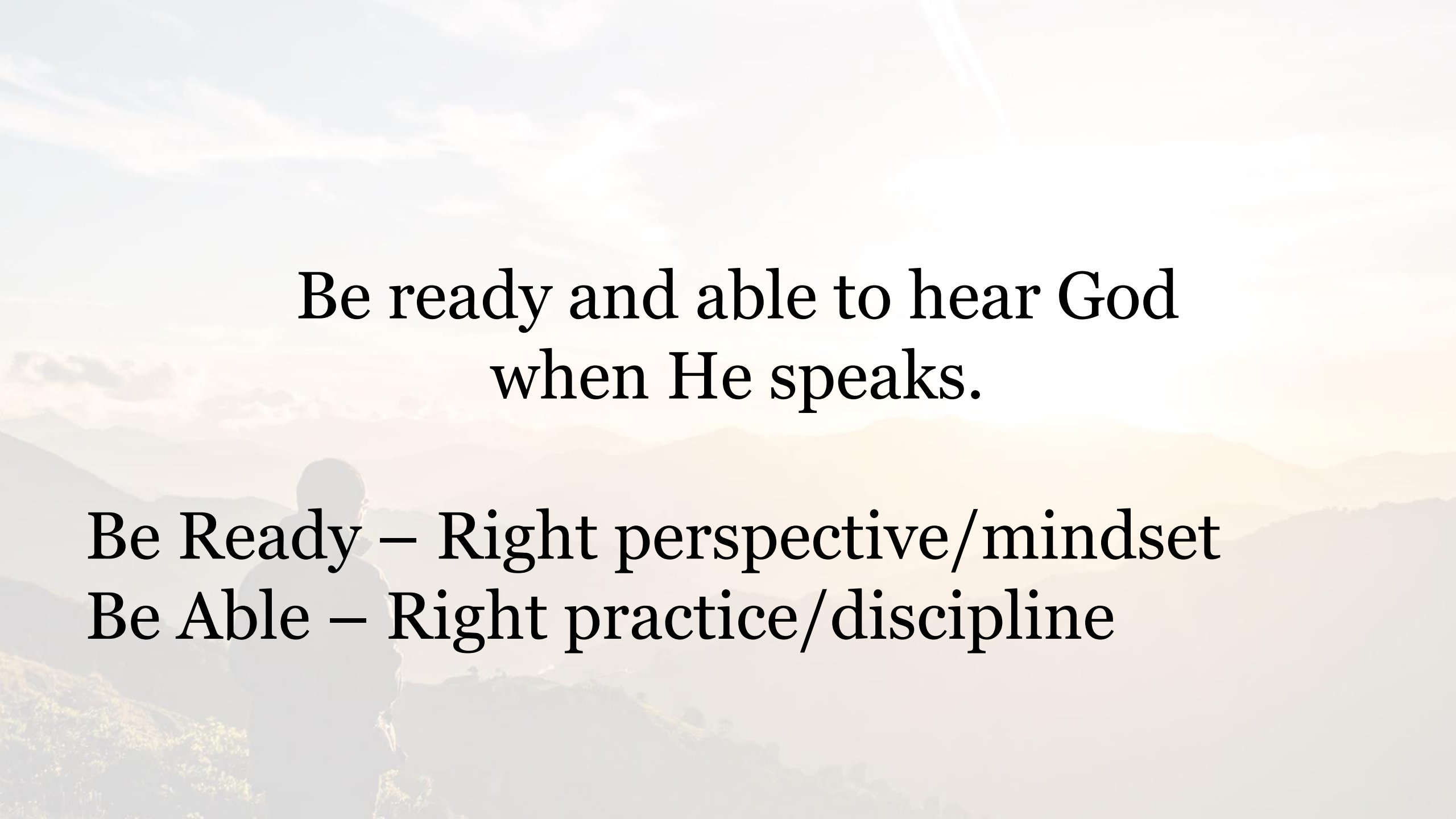
How much does God speak to us?
