What do these religions have in common?

Humans and the world are flawed

- Something fundamentally wrong with us
- The world is broken
  - Pain, hate, violence, famine, war....

What do these religions have in common?

There is a god to please/a way to follow

- A god that is angry with us and our brokenness
- Perfection that can be achieved and should be sought after

What do these religions have in common?

It's on you

- You have to work to appease/please your god
- Your enlightenment/nirvana/perfection is dependent on who you are and how you act

What's so special about Christianity?

Try as we might we can't win God's favor

- Our works and services will not earn us "heaven points"

- Micah 6:6-8

What so special about Christianity?

Jesus was not a good moral teacher

- He is our appeasement
- Through Him we are forgiven and redeemed
- Romans 5:1
