Centrality of Global Missions

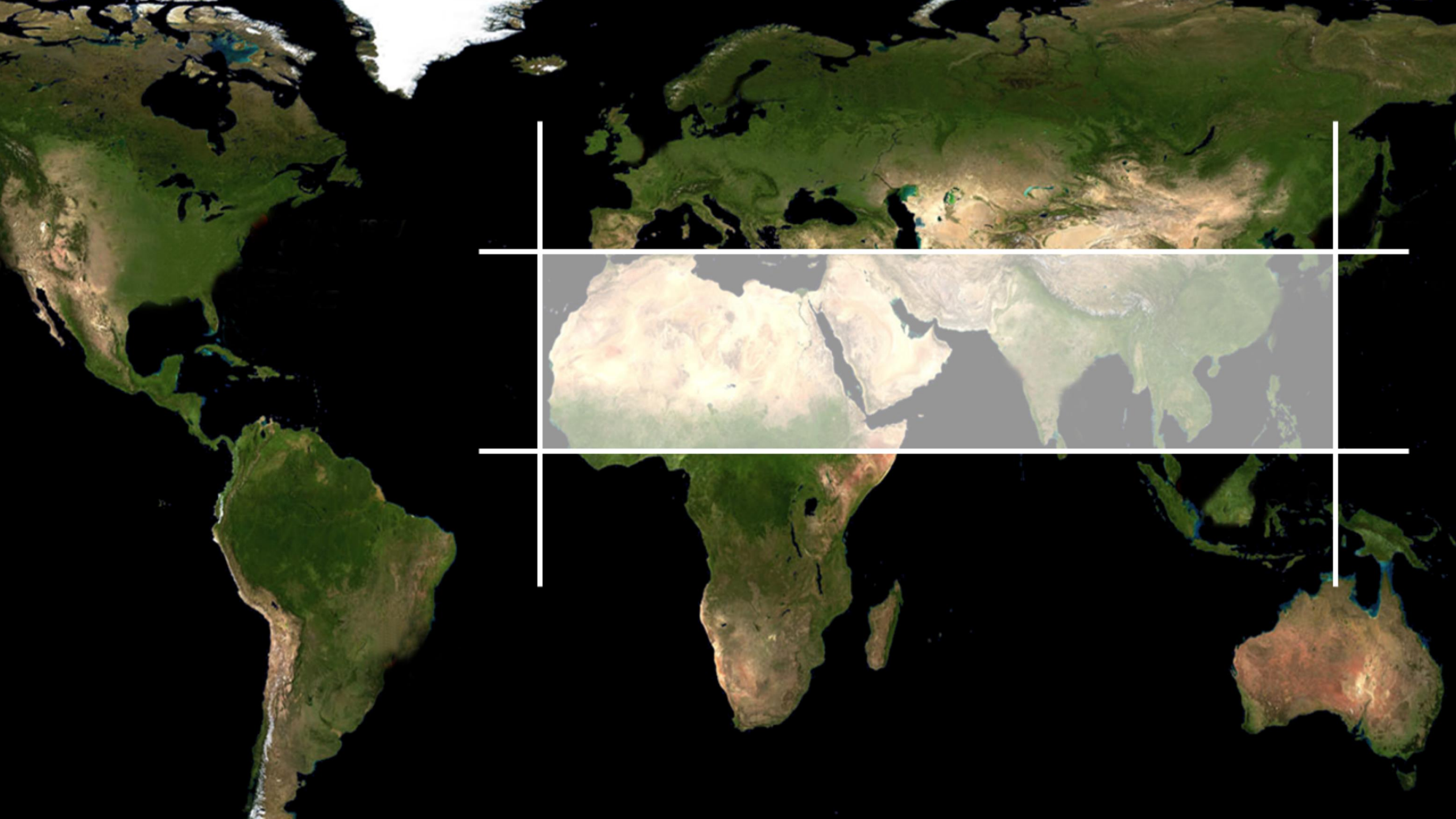
- From the Beginning (Gen 12:3, Is 49:6)

Urgency of Global Missions

 - 30% of the Globe Still Unreached



Urgency of Global Missions

- Reached vs Unreached
 - 30% of the 'People Groups' Still Unreached
- Frontier/Pioneer Global Missions
