Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things.


TRUTH GOODNESS BEAUTY

- Relativism/pluralism
 - "all the people did whatever seemed right in their own eyes.-Judges 17:9
- Truth is unknowable
 - John 18:37-38
- But we operate as though truth is objective
 - The truth will set you free!

Gospel Truth

- Jesus was no relativist
 - John 1
 - Jesus spoke to the people once more and said, "I am the light of the world. If you follow me, you won't have to walk in darkness, because you will have the light that leads to life.-John 8:12
- Nor pluralist
 - I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life. No one comes to the Father except through me.-John 14:6

- Humbly
